CIRCULAR

**Subject:- Elections to three Municipal Corporations of Delhi –  
Filing of affidavits in Form 21 and 22 in regard to criminal  
background, if any, assets and liabilities and educational  
qualifications of the candidate filing nomination paper –  
Complaints regarding.**

Two affidavits in Form 21 and 22 appended to the Delhi Municipal Corporation (Election of Councillors) Rules, 2012, and prescribed in Rule 18 of the said Rules, are required to be filed by every candidate while filing nomination paper for an election to a ward of a Corporation. Non-filing of the said affidavits or not filing in the complete form would amount to rejection of nomination paper of the defaulting candidate.

It is informed to all concerned that any challenge to the correctness of the information contained in the said affidavits can be made by filing election petition in the court of the concerned District Judge, Delhi, as prescribed in section 15 of the Delhi Municipal Corporation Act, 1957, or a complaint in this context can also be lodged before the 'competent court' under the Law and provisions of Indian Penal Code, directly by the complainant.
